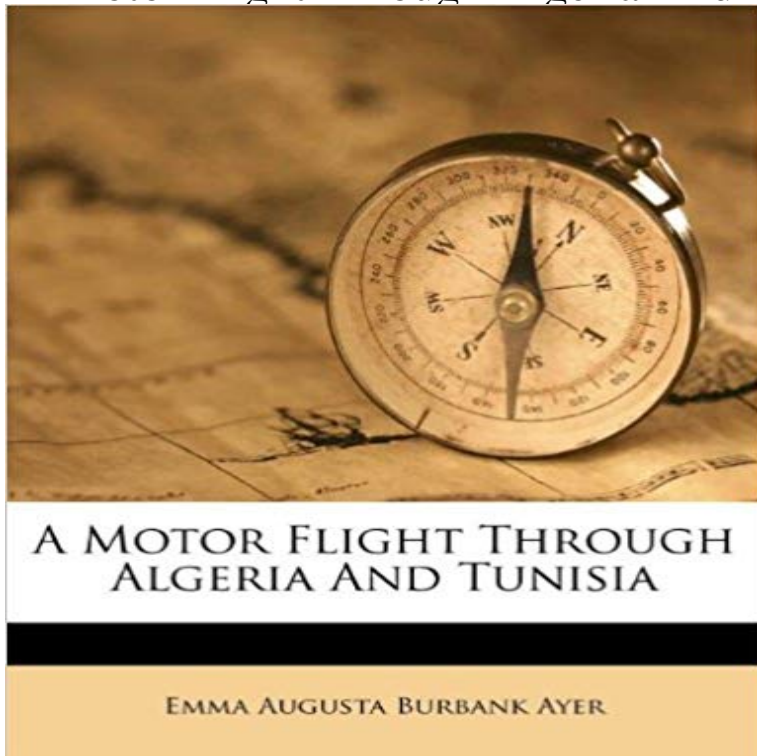


A Motor Flight Through Algeria And Tunisia
