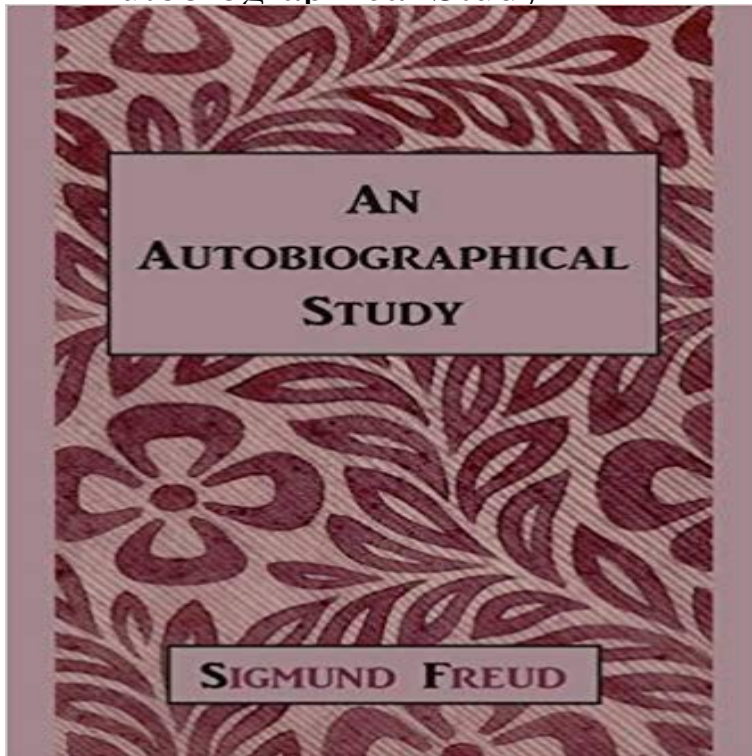


An Autobiographical Study
