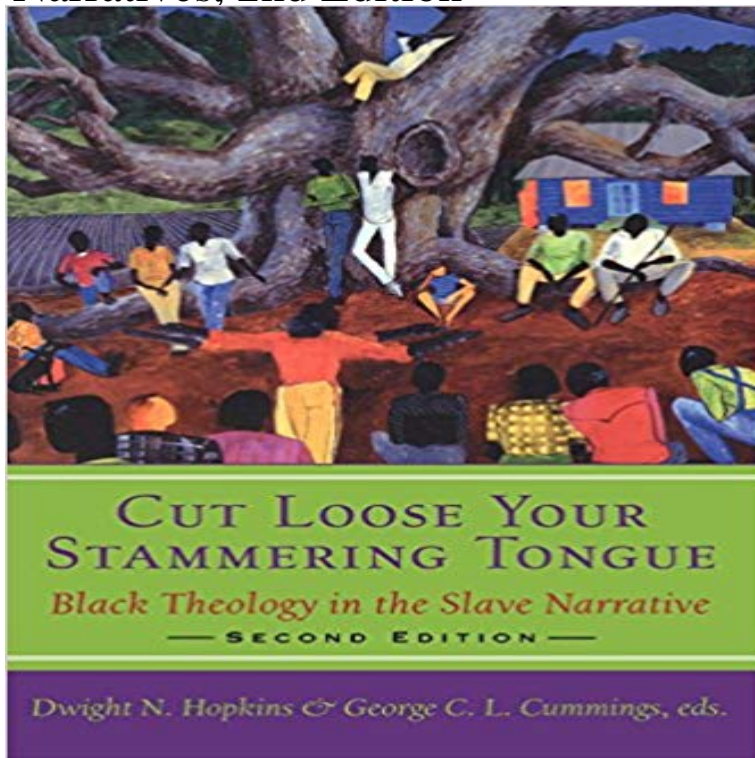


## Cut Loose Your Stammering Tongue: Black Theology in the Slave Narratives, 2nd Edition
