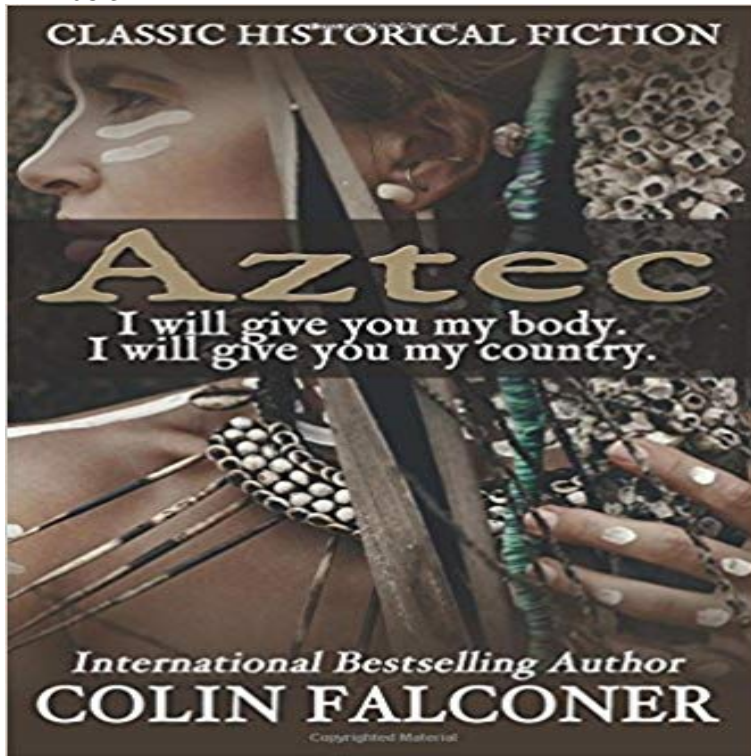


Aztec
