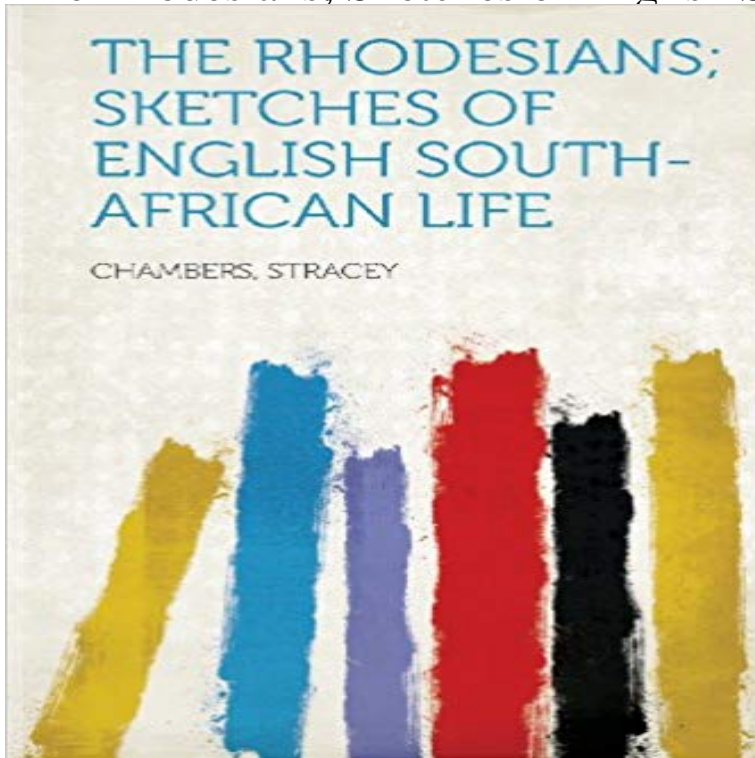


## The Rhodesians; Sketches of English South-African Life
