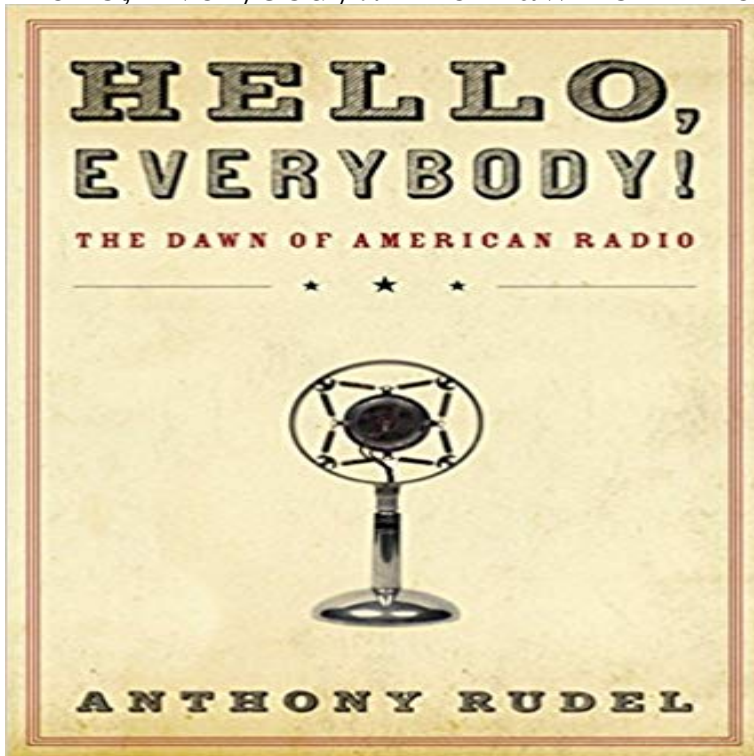


## Hello, Everybody!: The Dawn of American Radio
