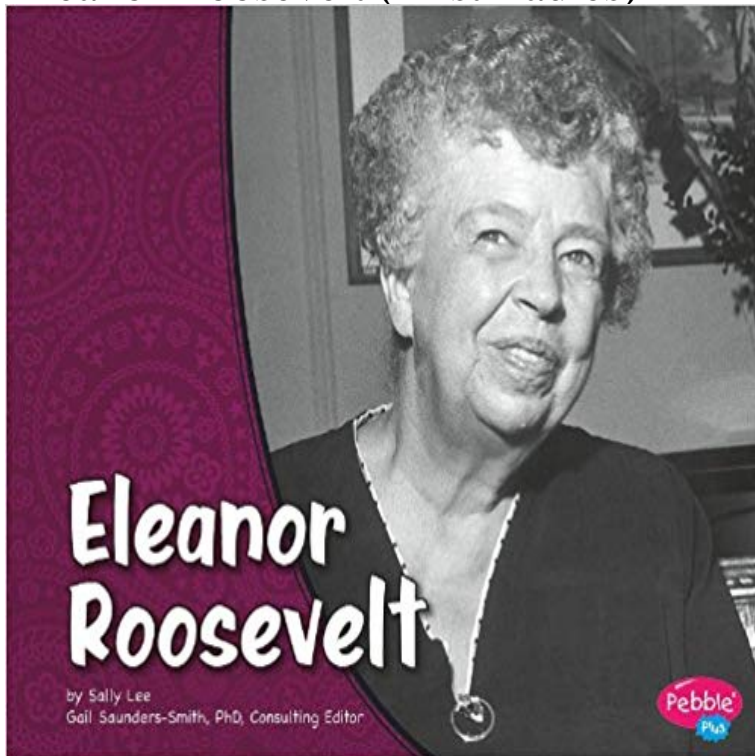


Eleanor Roosevelt (First Ladies)
