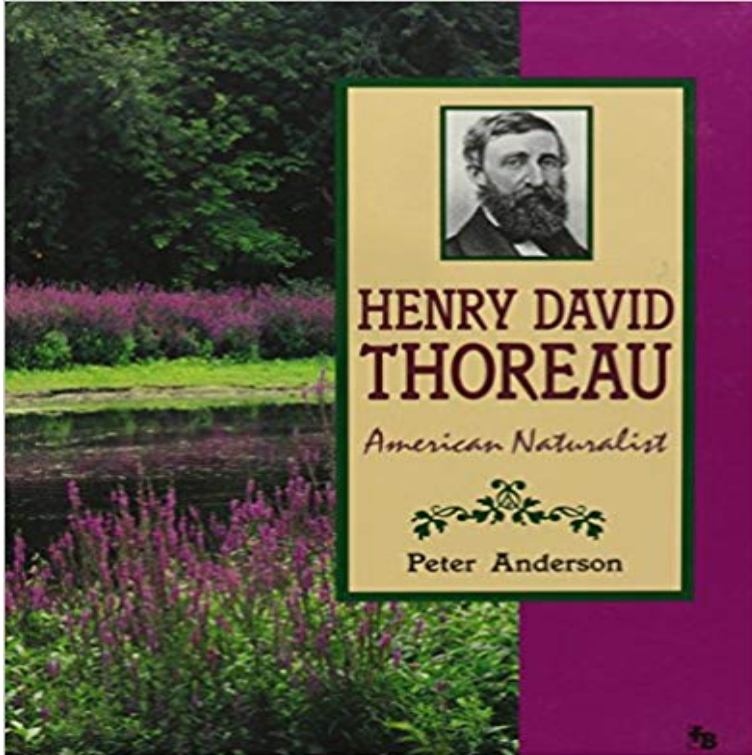


Henry David Thoreau: Naturalist (First Books--American Conservationists)
