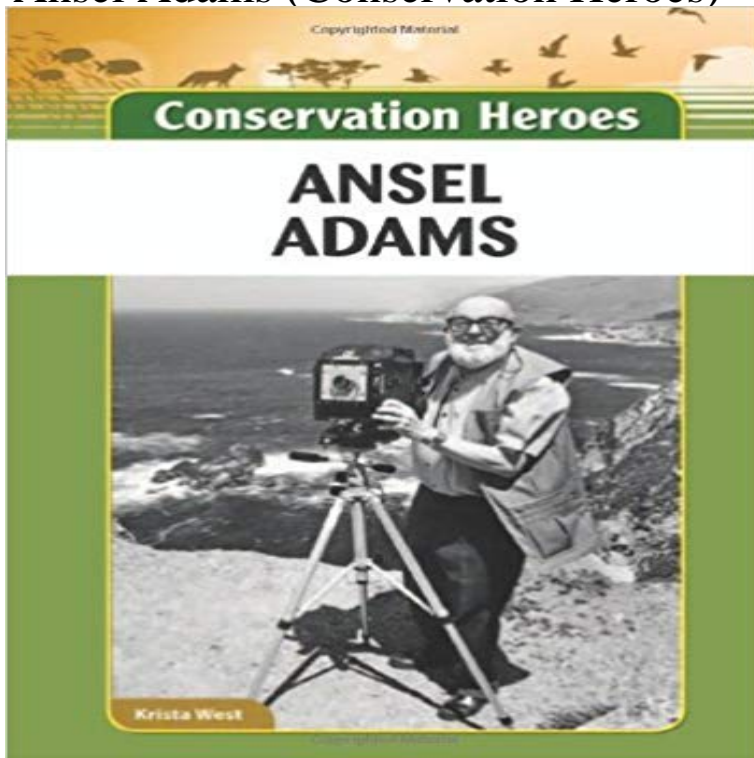


Ansel Adams (Conservation Heroes)
