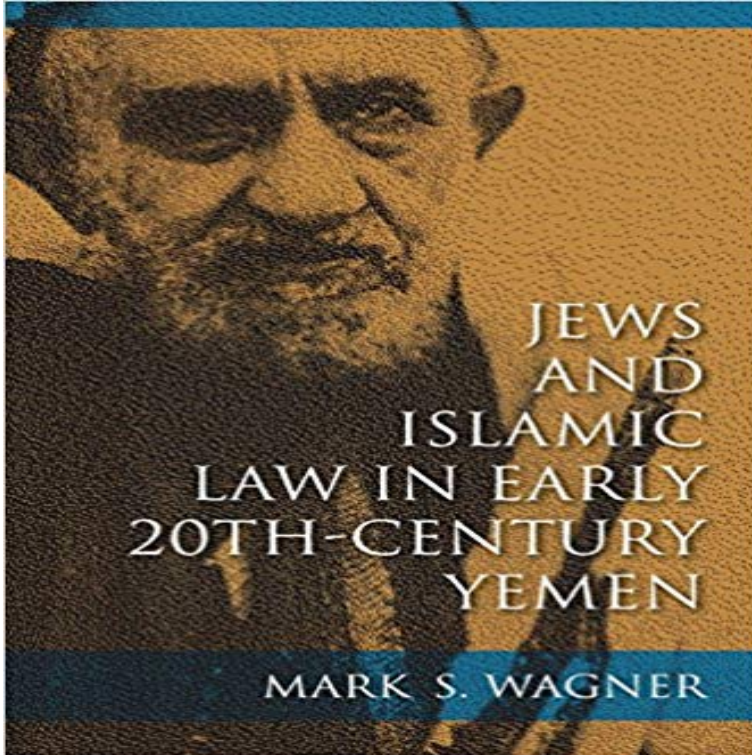


## Jews and Islamic Law in Early 20th-Century Yemen (Indiana Series in Sephardi and Mizrahi Studies)

Wagner draws on autobiographical writings to study the careers of three Jewish intermediaries who used their knowledge of Islamic law to manipulate the sharia for their own benefit and for the good of their community. The result is a fresh perspective on the place of religious minorities in Muslim societies.
