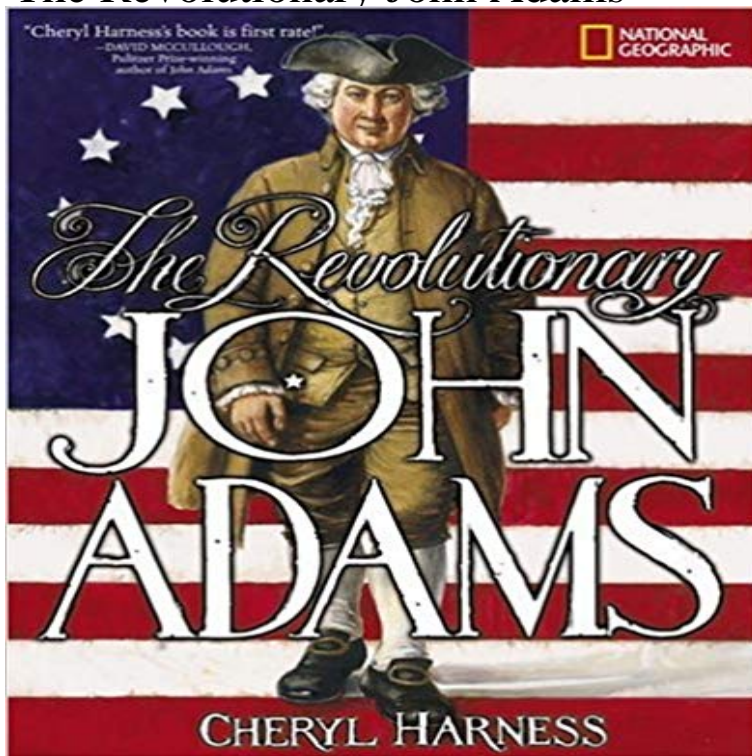


## The Revolutionary John Adams
