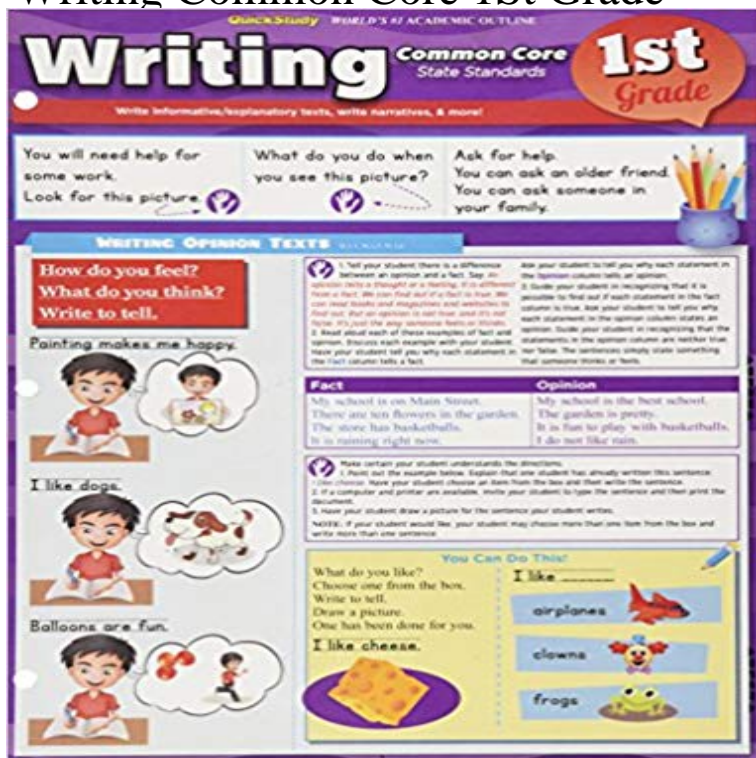


Writing Common Core 1st Grade
