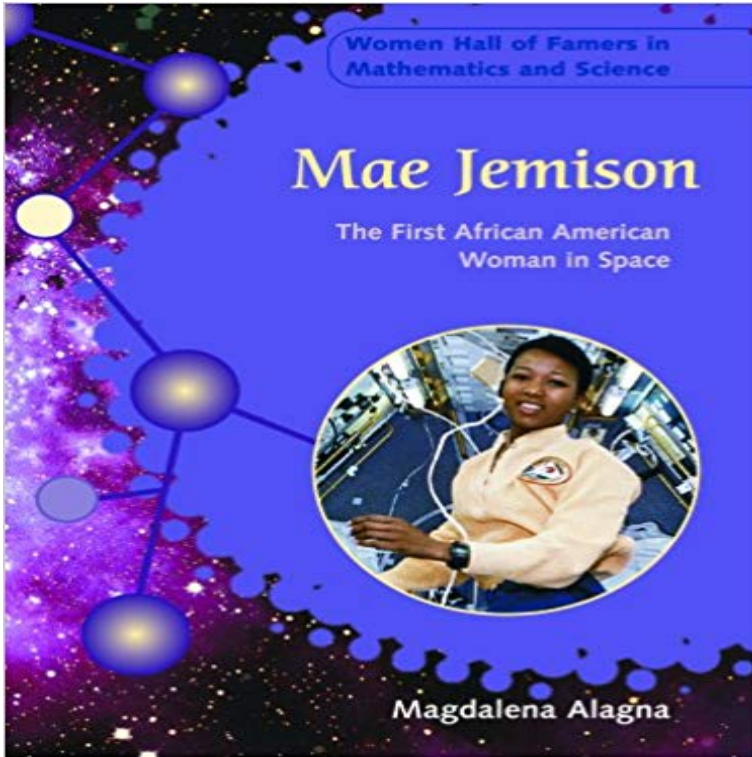


Mae Jemison: The First African American Woman in Space (Women Hall of Famers in Mathematics and Science)
