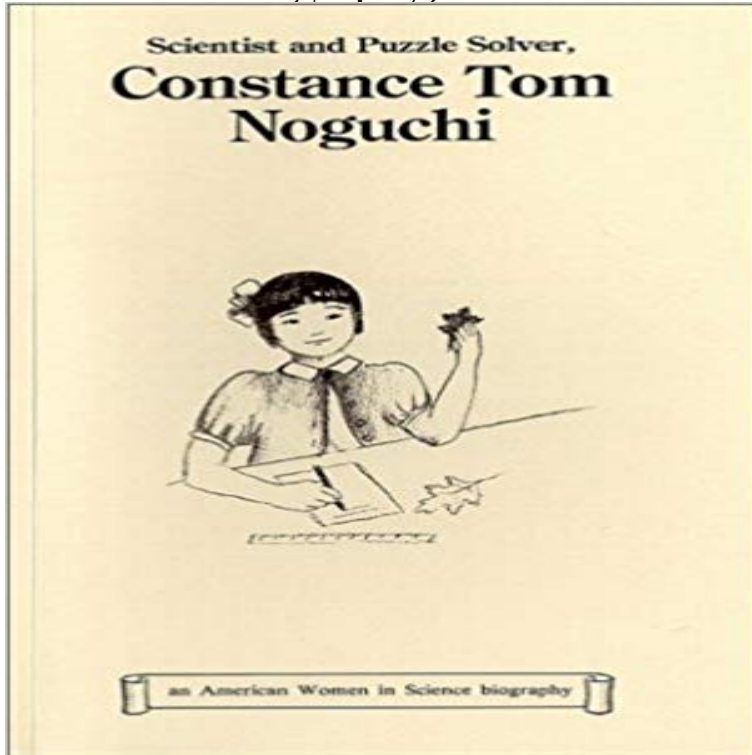


## Scientist and Puzzle Solver, Constance Tom Noguchi (American Women in Science Biography)
