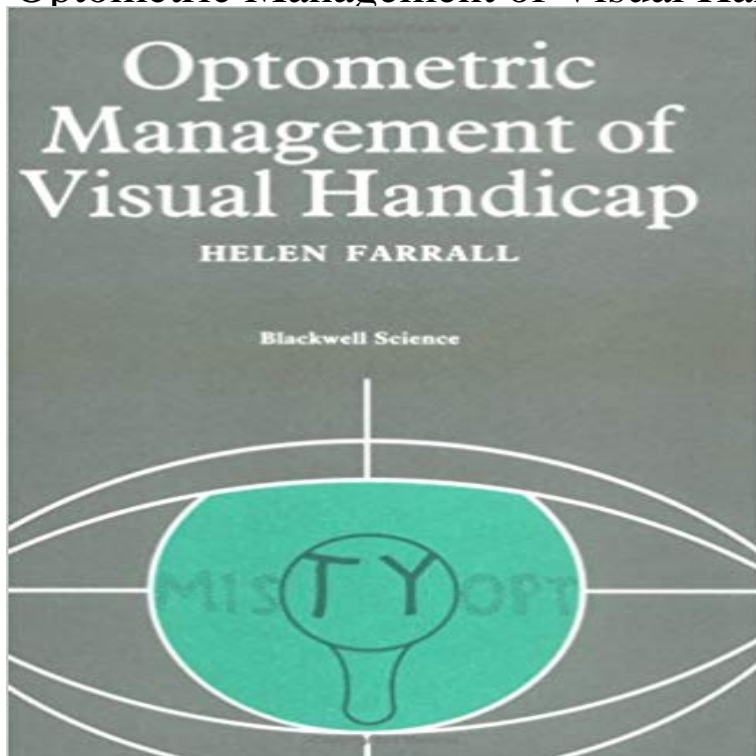


Optometric Management of Visual Handicap (Modern Optometry)
