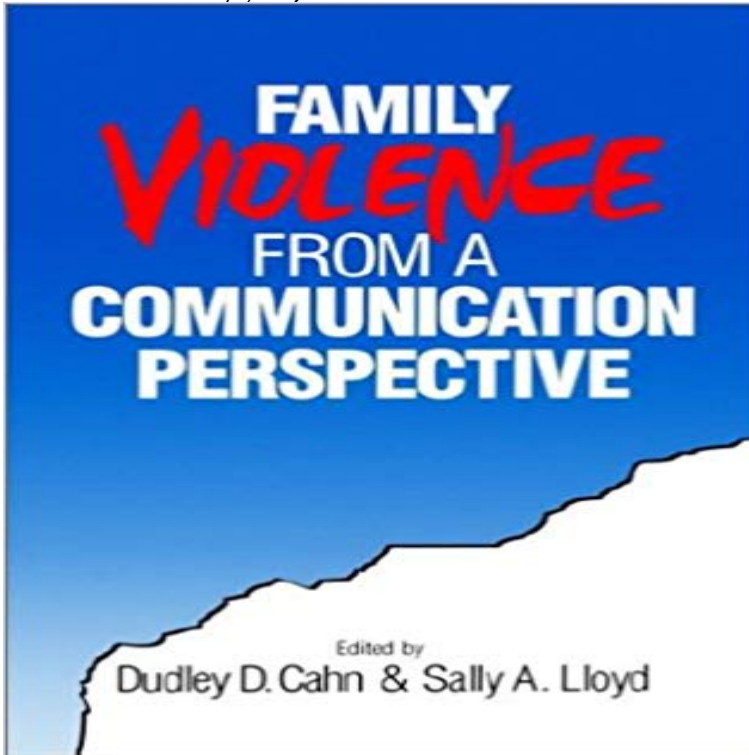


## Family Violence from a Communication Perspective (Men and Masculinity; 3)
