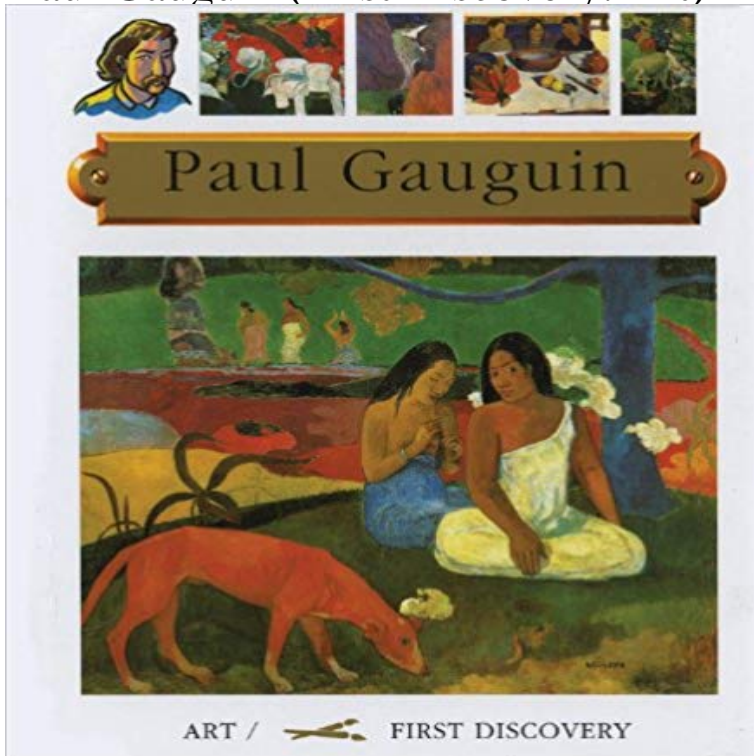


Paul Gauguin (First Discovery: Art)
