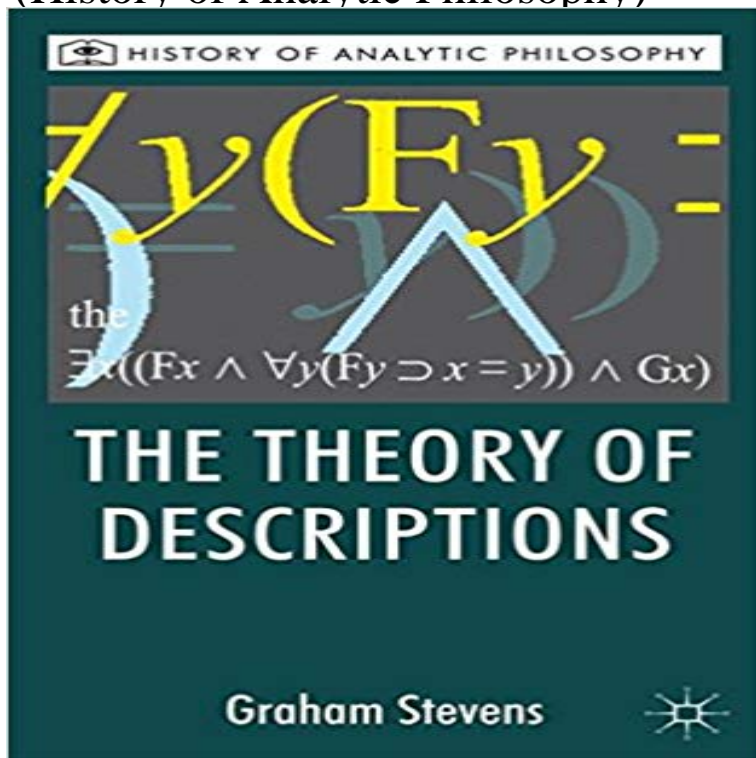


The Theory of Descriptions: Russell and the Philosophy of Language (History of Analytic Philosophy)
