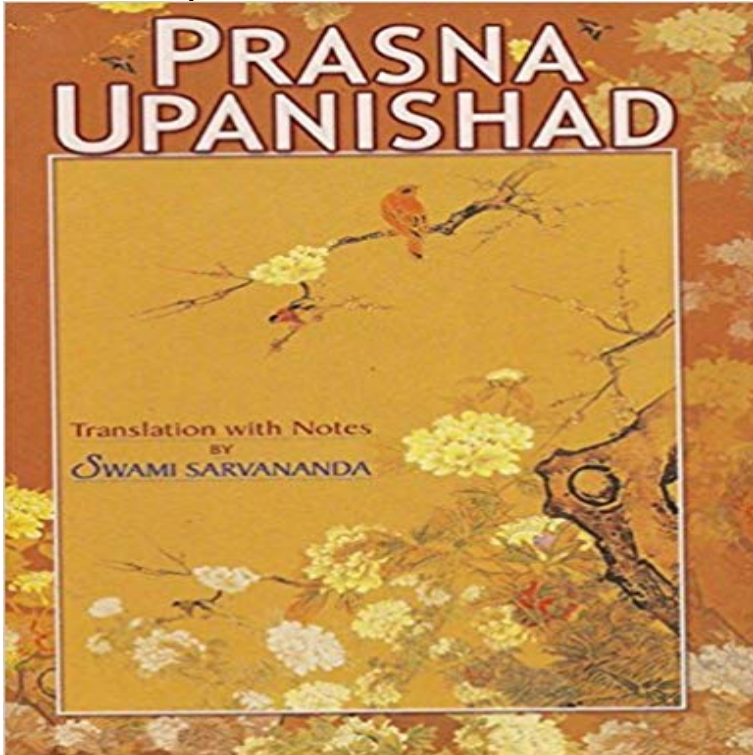


Prasna Upanishad: Translation With Notes By Swami Sarvananda
