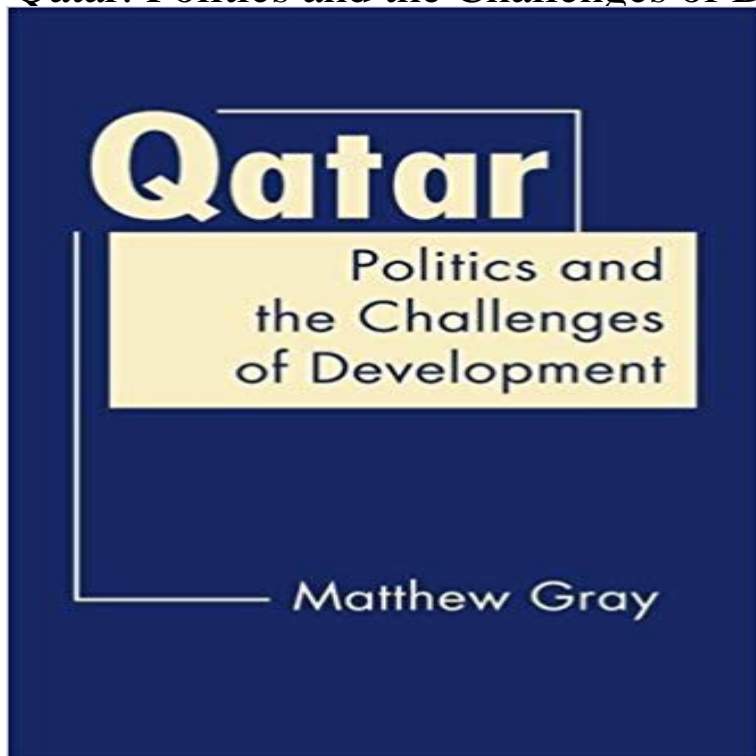


## Qatar: Politics and the Challenges of Development
