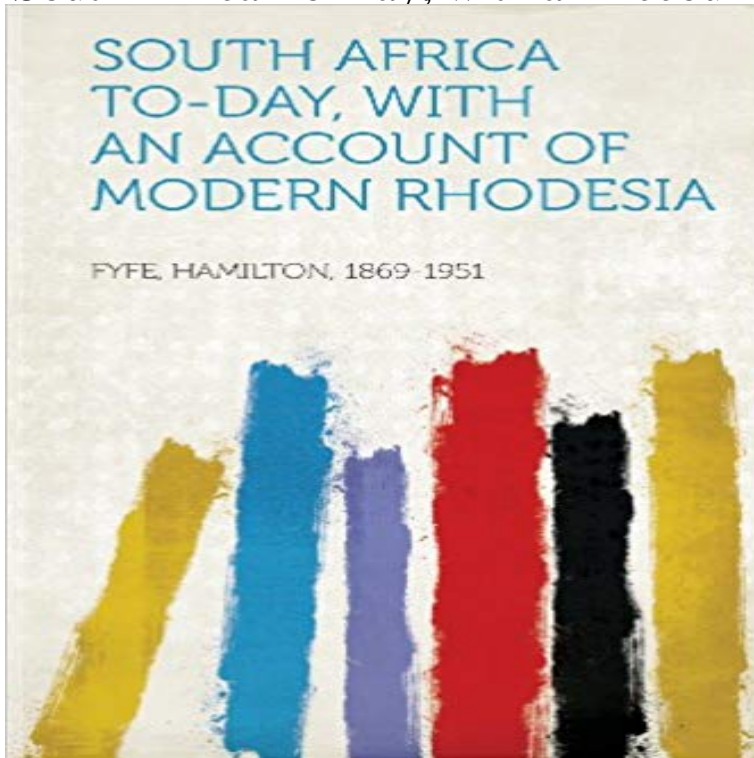


South Africa To-Day, with an Account of Modern Rhodesia
