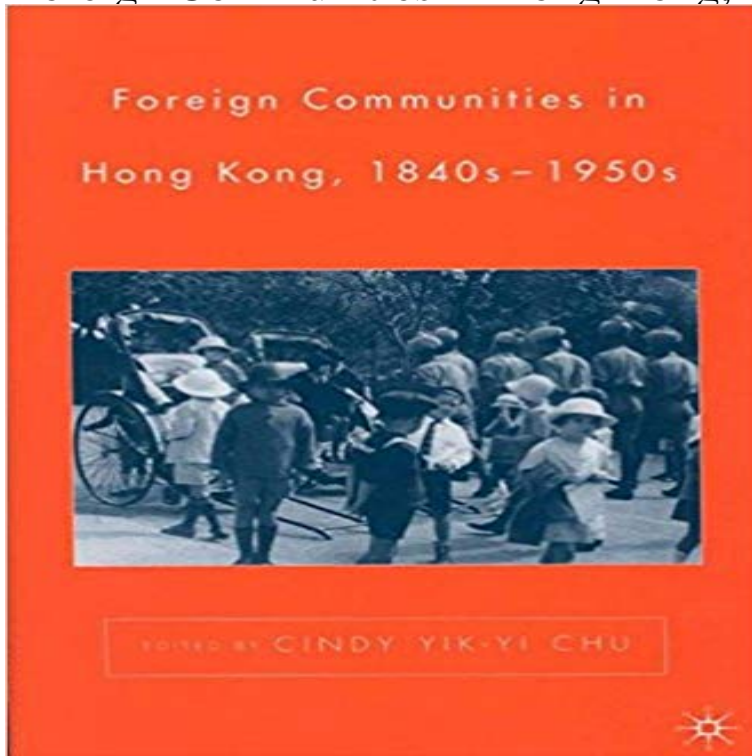


Foreign Communities in Hong Kong, 1840s-1950s
