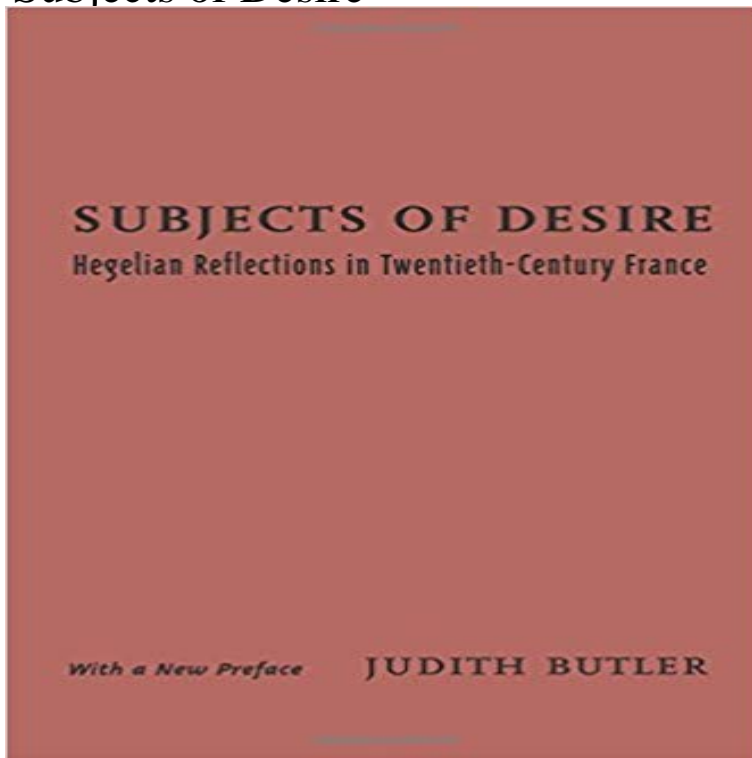


Subjects of Desire
