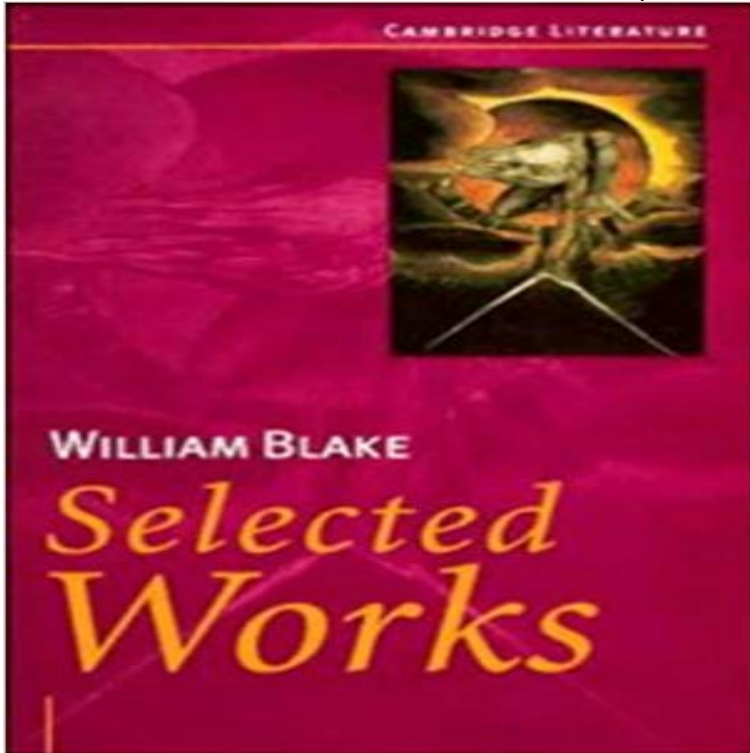


William Blake: Selected Works (Cambridge Literature)
