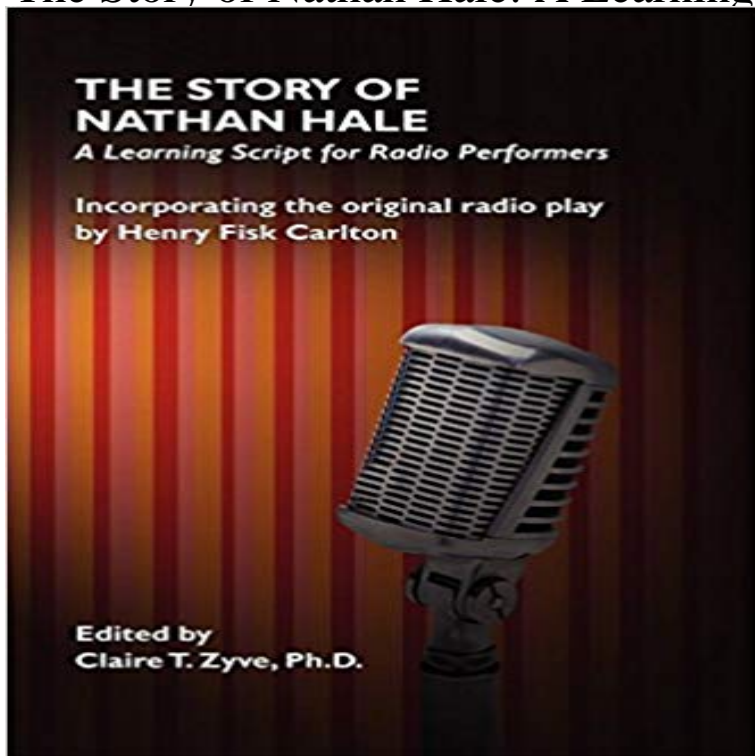


# The Story of Nathan Hale: A Learning Script for Radio Performers
