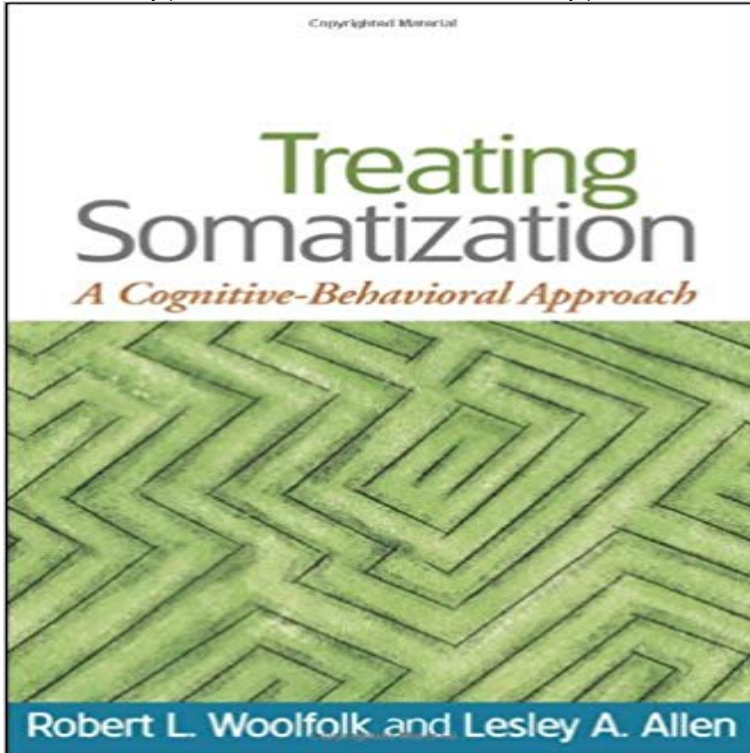


Treating Somatization: A Cognitive-Behavioral Approach
