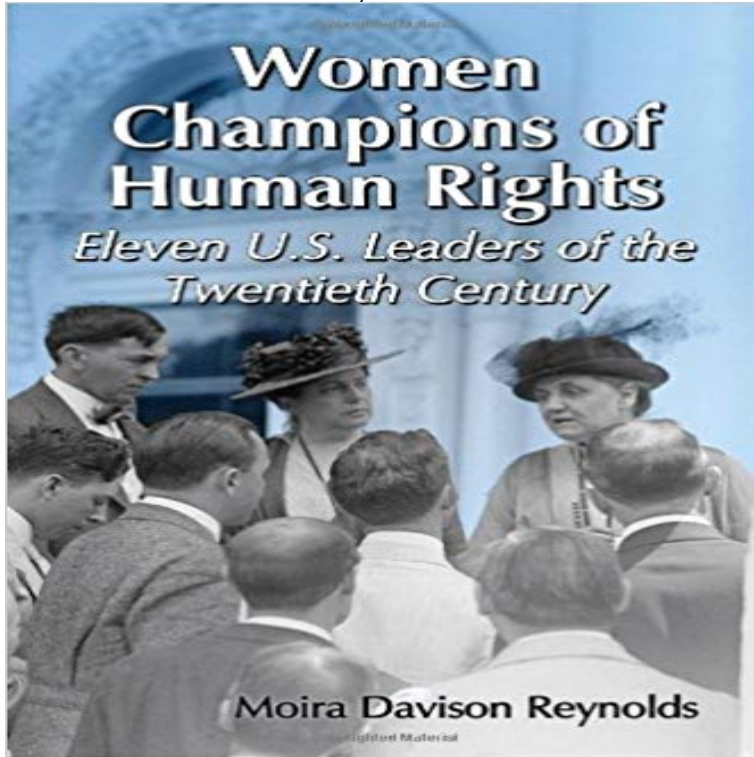


Women Champions of Human Rights: Eleven U.S. Leaders of the Twentieth Century
