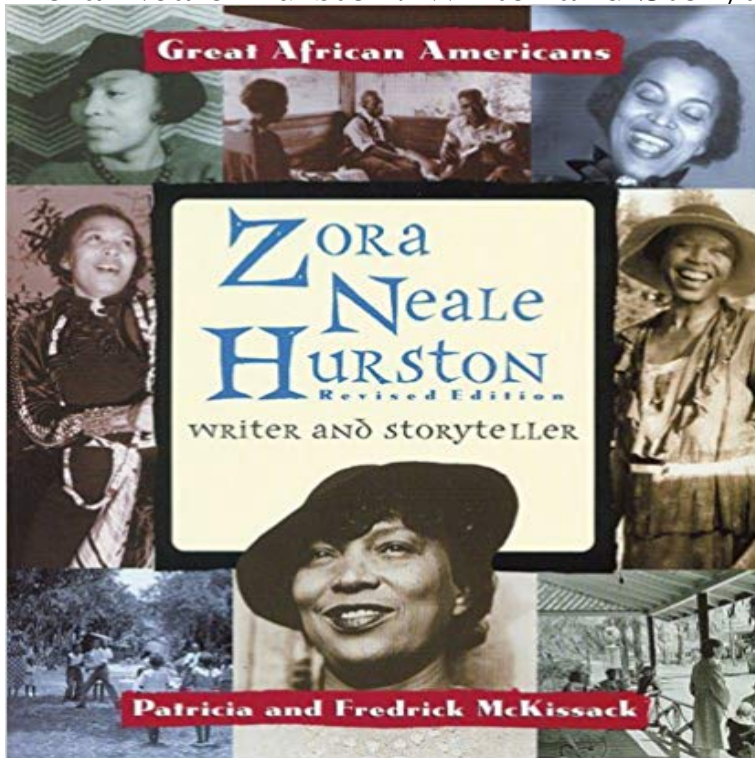


Zora Neale Hurston: Writer and Storyteller (Great African Americans)
